How will you manage water supply?

Rainbow Shores is committed to water conservation and will employ all possible means to responsibly manage this valuable resource.

Is there enough water in Rainbow Beach to support this development?

A recent report by Sinclair Knight Mertz has identified that there is adequate water supply for Rainbow Shores Stage 2 even without applying any water saving measures.

Will you be recycling water?

Rainbow Shores is committed to applying best practice water management including bringing treated water from the council's treatment plant back to the development for outdoor water use such as car washing, gardening, etc. Recycled water will be used in Rainbow Shores and possibly other future developments in Rainbow Beach. It will not affect current local residents.

Will Cooloola Shire ratepayers have to pay for this infrastructure?

No. The costs of this infrastructure will be covered by the developer.

Does the development of Rainbow Shores compromise the water available to development elsewhere?

No. Rainbow Shores water management plan takes into account all land designated for development in the Cooloola Coast Strategic Plan. There is adequate water available for all future development and growth identified in this regional plan.
